## *January* Saving Lives During the Polar Vortex

The Polar Vortex hit in January, and we continued to do street outreach to urge people to seek shelter indoors. Even still, two of our guests were <u>found unresponsive</u> in Georgetown and were close to death from exposure. Thankfully, our other guests who found them quickly called 911 and saved their lives.

## *February* Our response: Hypothermia Outreach Team

Because of the harsh winter and near deaths, we partnered with Georgetown University to create a volunteer <u>Hypothermia</u> <u>Outreach Team</u> to do street outreach on the coldest winter nights.





## *March* GMC Testifies at Congress

Gunther testified at a <u>congressional hearing</u> that examined the shortage of psychiatric beds, speaking eloquently about the relationship between mental health and homelessness. You can watch his testimony <u>here</u>.

April Success Stories Abound!

In April, we were able to find an out-of-the-box housing solution for one of our shelter residents. Additionally, two of our guests finally agreed to go into treatment for their addictions. We also saved the life of someone else by calling an ambulance while he was having a heart attack.

Staff and guests took a field trip to support the <u>Washington</u> <u>Nationals</u>, DC's baseball team. It was a night of chili dogs, peanuts, and fun! Everyone showed their "natitude!"

Changes in our Clothing Closet

In August, we relocated our <u>clothing closet</u> to a smaller space and thus had to limit the kinds of clothing donations we can accept. Socks, underwear, and other essentials are now <u>what's</u> <u>needed most</u>!


